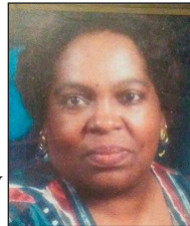
She was preceded in death by her mother, Nellie Ardean Pittman; father, Earnest Holmes; brother, Larry Weary.

Linda Burkes

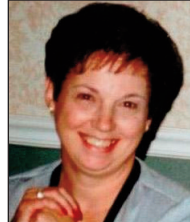
Oct. 4, 1949 - Oct. 3, 2018
