Nov. 27, 1963 - June 9, 2018

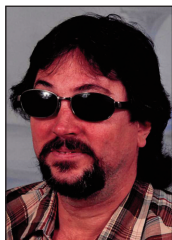
Memorial services for Clay Barton Barron, 54, will be held at 5:30 pm June 18, 2018.
